

OutSystems SA/L Hackathon 2026: Terms and Conditions

This OutSystems SA/L Hackathon 2026 (the “**Hackathon**”) is organised by **OutSystems Singapore Pte. Ltd.** (the “**Organiser**”).

By registering for or participating in the Hackathon, each participant confirms that they are authorised to participate on behalf of their organisation and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions (“**Terms**”).

1. Purpose

The Hackathon is a customer-only initiative designed to encourage the development of **production-ready agentic systems** using OutSystems AI Development Platform.

2. Eligibility

Participation is open only to existing OutSystems customers. All participants must take part on behalf of their organisation.

- **Team Structure:** Participation may be individual or in teams of up to three (3) members from the same organisation.
- **Business Case:** The innovation use case should preferably be backed by a business sponsor who supports the team’s participation in the hackathon.

The Organiser reserves the right to verify eligibility and reject entries that do not meet these requirements.

3. Hackathon Schedule

Key dates and deadlines are published on the official Hackathon landing page.

The Organiser reserves the right to amend the schedule where necessary. Any changes will be communicated to registered participants.

4. Entry and Submission

Entry is confirmed upon submission of the official registration form on the Hackathon landing page.

All submissions must:

- Be developed and executed using a Corporate OutSystems Developer Cloud (ODC) license under an active subscription
- Utilise Agent Workbench
- Meet the submission requirements
- Be original works and must not infringe any third-party intellectual property rights

5. Use of Third-Party Technologies

- External APIs, services, and libraries (e.g. OpenAI, Claude, Vertex AI) may be used, provided the core application is built and executed on ODC.
- Participants are solely responsible for:
 - Compliance with third-party licences
 - Any associated costs
 - Ensuring lawful and appropriate use of such technologies within their organisation

6. Intellectual Property Rights

- All intellectual property rights in the submission remain the property of the participating organisation.
- Participants grant the Organiser the right to use submission materials (including demos, videos, screenshots, and descriptions) for:
 - Hackathon administration and judging
 - Internal communications related to the Hackathon
- Any external or public marketing use (including press releases, websites, or social media) will be subject to the participating organisation's prior consent.

7. Judging and Results

- Submissions will be evaluated based on the judging criteria published on the Hackathon landing page.
- All judging decisions are final. In the event of a tie or exceptional circumstances, the Organiser reserves the right to determine the final outcome.

8. Prizes and Winner Participation

- Prizes are awarded to submissions that best meet the published evaluation criteria, as assessed by the judging panel.
- To be recognised as a winner, the participating organisation will be invited to take part in selected **winner engagement activities**, which may include:
 - Participation in an OutSystems podcast or video interview
 - Collaboration on a customer case study
 - Mention in an OutSystems press release
 - A speaking opportunity at OutSystems Innovator Day
- These activities are intended to celebrate and showcase the winning solution. Participation details and timelines will be agreed collaboratively between the Organiser and the winning organisation.

- If a winning organisation chooses not to participate in these activities, the Organiser reserves the right to withdraw or reassign the award.

9. Professional Conduct

Participants are expected to conduct themselves in a professional, respectful, and lawful manner throughout the Hackathon.

The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any participant or team for misconduct, inappropriate behaviour, or breach of these Terms or the Participation Rules.

10. Data Protection

Personal data will be processed solely for Hackathon administration, communication, and award purposes, in accordance with the **OutSystems Privacy Policy**:

The Organiser will handle personal data in accordance with applicable data protection laws and will not use participant data for unrelated commercial purposes.

11. Disclaimer and Liability

Participation in the Hackathon is voluntary.

Each participating organisation is responsible for managing its own resources, costs, and internal risks associated with participation.

The Organiser will not be responsible for costs or losses arising from the use of third-party services or infrastructure, except where liability cannot be excluded under applicable law.

12. Changes and Cancellation

The Organiser reserves the right to modify, suspend, or cancel the Hackathon due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

If any significant changes are made that affect how participants take part in the Hackathon (including changes to key dates, eligibility, submission requirements, judging criteria, or prizes), registered participants will be informed in advance where reasonably possible.

13. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms are governed by the laws of **Singapore**.

Any disputes arising out of or in connection with these Terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Singapore.

14. Acceptance

By registering for or participating in the Hackathon, participants confirm acceptance of these Terms and the associated Participation Rules.
